Tree Frog Foundation Paper Piecing Scrappy Quilt Pattern

This pattern was designed to be user friendly and is divided into blocks identified by letters and numbers. Each 7.5”x7.5 finished block is sized to fit on standard size printing paper. When complete, this quilt measures 67.5”x52.5” but can be resized as desired.

This is an beginner-intermediate level pattern. However, a basic understanding of foundation paper piecing prior to starting this design is required.

Understanding the Blocks

This quilt is designed with mostly one block style, by which I mean that most blocks are the same, only the fabric choices change. However, Blocks that boarder the outside of the frog may be slightly different and/or divided into sections. Within each block, pieces are labeled in the order in which they are sewn (1, 2, 3 etc.) and with the fabric color (using codes described on pages 3).

The Key

Edge of seam allowance - cut along this line -----

Seam line - sew along this line _____

Subject change- The blue line separates two different parts of the design (for example the frogs body and the background).

These changes will also be noted in the seam allowance.



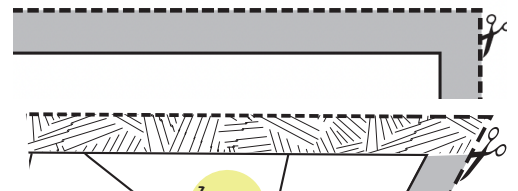
Letters and numbers with a rectangle indicate the block label

Letters and numbers in the rounded square represent the order section are sewn together



Seam Allowance - The seam allowance around the block is gray and The seam allowance between sections is patterned.

Two pieces that will be sewn together will have matching patterns. Notice that the seam allowance extends to the edge of the paper so some of the gray will not print. Please use a ruler to measure 1/4”.

FABRIC CHOICES

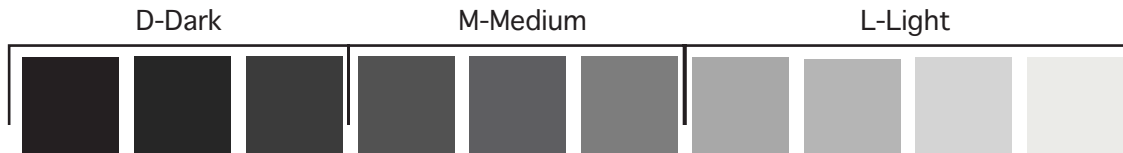
This quilt is designed as a way for you to use up your scraps. Therefore, there is not a list of every single color seen in the quilt example on page 8. If you are working with scraps, you could use as many colors as shown in the example or more. If you are purchasing fabric you may want to reduce the number of colors. The swatch charts on pages 4-5 will show you some examples of colors you could use. Since there are various ways this pattern could be done, the suggested fabric amounts should be taken as a general suggestion and may not be exact.

Examples of labels that will be used on blocks:

1/DG -1 means sew this piece first. D means dark. G means Green. The fabric you choose doesn't have to match the color of the circle. As long as the color is green and is dark it will work. ●

2/MNO -2 means sew this piece second. M means medium lightness. N means neutral. When N is listed before another hue letter, this means that its is a muted or less intense version of that hue. Lastly, O means orange. ●

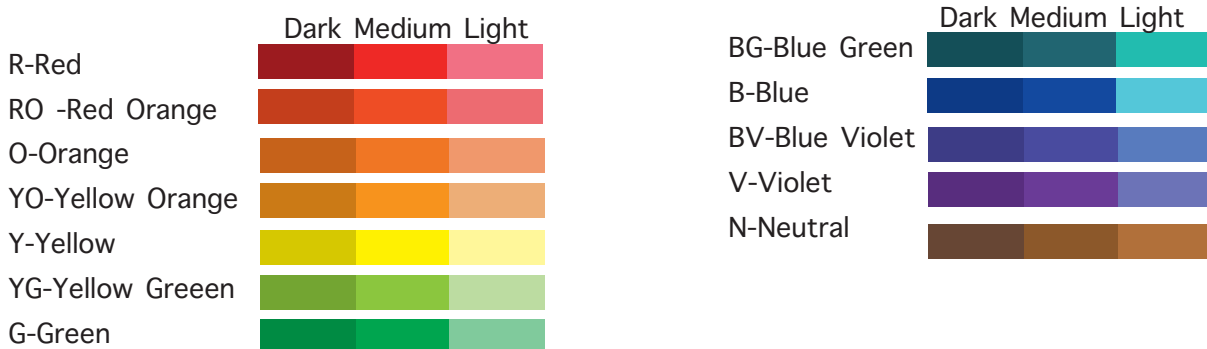
Gray-scale



The gray-scale indicates how light or dark a color is. The hue of the color is how warm or cool a color is (for example the word RED describes hue). If you wanted to get creative you could, in theory, use any hue. As long as you used the gray-scale, your quilt would be a uniquely colored frog. Hue

The hue will be indicated with a letter. The original colors will also be indicated by a colored circle. You may also refer to the design on page 8 or 9. The hue codes are:

Notice how there is more than one swatch for some labels. DB for example, means dark blue. You could have three or four colors for dark blue and alternate them for maximum variety or you could have one dark blue and reduce the number of fabrics you need. This is a personal design choice.

FABRIC RECOMMENDATIONS OPTION 2

Background Colors

Notice these colors are muted. Colors could be reduced and hues could be changed.

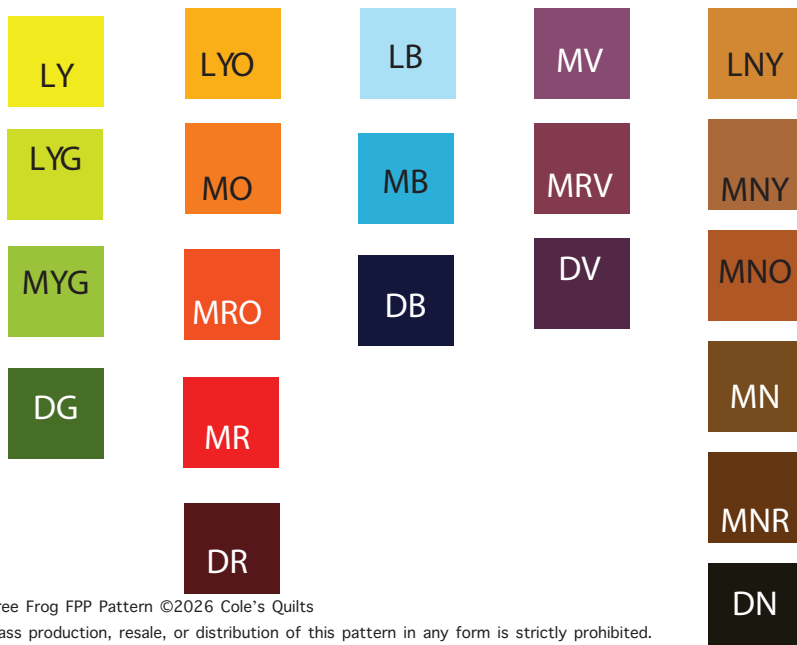
Upper right upper left lower right Center *lower Left and branch

Notice these colors are brighter than the background. Colors could be reduced and hues could be changed.

Frog Body Feet and Eyes Belly and inside



This shows a reduced list of fabrics with only one color per label. This could be reduced further by making the background all one hue or reducing the hues of the frog.

FABRIC AMOUNT SUGGESTIONS

The fabric recommendations are not listed for each individual color but for each group of colors.

1 3/4 yard: neutrals (Frog belly, branch and some background)

1 3/4 yard: greens (frog body)

1 y Blues (frog belly, legs and some background)

1/4 yard: Reds (frog feet and eyes), Red-Oranges (frog feet), Oranges (frog feet), Yellow-Oranges (frog feet), Yellows (frog feet and body), violets (frog belly and some background)
